The health of Aboriginal Australians is not too hard to fix. Aboriginal peoples know this. That's why they have established over 130 primary health care services, run by Aboriginal peoples for Aboriginal peoples, and these now deliver over 1.6 million episodes of care.

They have also invested leadership for health improvements in NACCHO. NACCHO is an award-winning organisation of elected Aboriginal leaders in health. Their job is to make the health system equitable for Aboriginal peoples. This means that they work to reduce the unequal opportunities that Aboriginal peoples have to be healthy.

Many Australians think that Aboriginal peoples have the same opportunities as other Australians. Unfortunately, there is overwhelming and incontrovertible evidence that this is not the case.
